Tried and True Perennials

Perennials are the plants that we can count on. Rain or shine, hot or cold, they are there in our landscapes flourishing and providing beauty to our garden beds and containers. In this seminar, Garden Guru Mike Westphal shows us some of the best perennials for the Hampton Roads area, for both sun and shade, to enjoy year after year.

PLANTS YOU CAN TRUST

Perennials are the go-to plant for the gardener who wants bed fillers all year-round. For the most part, perennials go dormant in the winter and come back each year. The way a perennial goes dormant depends on the plant. Sometimes it is just the blooms, others need to be pruned back almost to the ground in the winter. Overall, perennials require only occaisional pruning and minimal care, making them extremely easy plants to enjoy.

How do you know which perennials will work for you? Follow this guide from Mike, the Garden Guru, for the tried and true perennials of the Hampton Roads area, as well as USDA zones, height/width of the plants, and the level of deer resistance

SUN LOVERS

Daylilies -

- Zones 3-9
- Grows 1-3 feet tall
- Deer resistant

Verbena -

- Zones 6-10
- Grows 1 foot tall by 3 feet wide
- Deer resistant

Hibiscus –

- Zones 4-9
- Grows anywhere from 3-6 feet tall and wide
- Deer resistant

Iris -

- Zones 3-9
- Grows 1-2 feet tall and wide
- Deer resistant

Salvia -

- Zones 7-10
- Grows 3-4 feet tall and wide
- Fairly deer resistant

Ruellia (Mexican Petunia) -

- 7ones 8-11
- Grows about 3 feet tall and wide
- Fairly deer resistant

Catmint -

- 7ones 3-9
- Grows about 1-3 feet tall and wide
- Deer resistant

Rudbeckia (Black-Eyed Susan) -

- 7ones 4-9
- Grows about 2 feet tall and 3 feet wide
- Deer resistant

Miscanthus Adagio -

- Zones 5-9
- Grows about 3-4 feet tall and wide
- Deer resistant

Dianthus (Pinks) -

- Zones 3-9
- Grows anywhere from 6 inches to 2 feet tall and 1-2 feet wide
- Fairly deer resistant

Coreopsis (Tickseed) -

- Zones 3-9
- Grows about 1-3 feet tall and wide
- Fairly deer resistant

Phlox (Tall Phlox) -

- Zones 4-8
- Grows about 2-4 feet tall and wide
- Deer resistant

Purple Heart -

- Zones 7-10
- Grows about 1 foot tall and 3-5 feet wide
- Fairly deer resistant

Sedums -

- Zones 3-11
- Grown as ground cover
- Fairly deer resistant

Mint -

- Zones 4-10
- Grown anywhere from 1-3 feet high and wide
- Spreader
- Deer resistant

Strawberries -

- 7ones 5-10
- Low-growing spreader
- NOT deer resistant

SHADE LOVERS

Hostas -

- Zones 3-9
- Grows anywhere from 1-4 feet high and wide
- NOT deer resistant

Ferns –

- Zones 5-9
- Grows about 2 feet high and wide
- Deer resistant

Heuchera (Coral Bells) -

- Zones 4-9
- Grows about 1-2 feet high and wide
- Deer resistant

Hellebores (Lenten Rose) -

- 7ones 6-9
- Grows about 1-2 feet high and wide
- Deer resistant

Lysimachia (Creeping Jenny) -

- Zones 3-9
- Grows about 3-6 feet high and 1-2 feet wide
- Deer resistant
